## Project Definition and Objective

*Port of Anchorage Intermodal Expansion Project, Construction of Interim Floating Dock*

The objective of this project was to construct a floating dock capable of berthing six 30-foot-long U.S. Coast Guard boats used for maritime security operations at the Port and throughout Alaska.

This project was part of the Port of Anchorage Intermodal Expansion Project, for which ICRC provides program management. This \$375 million effort includes the creation of 135 acres of new land through tidal fill activities and the construction of more than 8,800 feet of new waterfront wharf.

## Tasks

The tasks performed by ICRC for this project included:

- Materials procurement
- Permitting
- Construction
- All aspects of project management, including continuous cost, schedule and quality reporting

## Impact

ICRC delivered the following results:

- Completed the project under budget
- Met the fast-track project schedule by:
  - Procuring the federally furnished long lead materials
  - Obtaining needed regulatory permits
  - Simultaneously securing the construction subcontractor
- Completed construction without disrupting ongoing shipping operations
